Manual harvest

Maceration for 12 days in concrete tanks, light punching and pumping- daily supported, then aged in oak barrels for 10 months.

Fruity wine and thin with undergrowth notes, small red fruit (strawberry, raspberry) and very floral.

Versatile, it can be enjoyed on youth or wait a few years of aging.

It is perfect with white meat (poultry, veal) or will simply taste in aperitif.

Serving temperature: 17/18 ° C.
